Fitting your Flat Cats Window Protection

Thank-you for purchasing our product.

After opening your package, please check that you have the correct Flat Cat/s and a roll of 20mm self adhesive hook and loop fastener. Each screen will have a label showing its size.

We recommend the following when fitting your screen:

- 1) Hold your screen up to your chosen window to make sure that it is the correct size. If the size appears to be correct then place the screen to one side.
- 2) Take the roll of self adhesive hook and loop provided and measure either a full height or width on the flat part of the static frame of the window and cut a length from the roll.
- 3) Once you have cut the length required, remove the backing tape and stick to the window frame. If you are in doubt regarding the position hold up the Flat Cat once again to ensure that it will sit over the self adhesive part once applied to the frame.
- 4) Repeat the above until you have hook and loop around all four sides of the window.
- 5) Hold up your Flat Cat and simply press into place over the "hook" part which is already stuck to the window frame.
- 6) With our fixings you have the ability to add one length of 20mm fixings to the frame but, where you are able, you may also wish to add a second strip of 20mm wide fixings to provide more grip. We provide extra fixings so you can use as you are able depending on the widths of your frames. In most cases a single set of fixings is quite sufficient.

Your Flat Cat is now fitted and ready to use.

To remove simply take one of the corners of the screen and tear away from the hook and loop fastening it to the window. Simply pat back down to reapply to the window.

The self adhesive part of the hook and loop remains in place on the window frame. When removing these in the future the best way is, rather than pulling away from the frames to turn the start of the tape on itself and remove slowly drawing the tape along next to the tape which is already in place, this will remove the majority of the sticky residue. Any remaining sticky residue can be removed with some white spirit on a rag.
